Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicants must have applied for enrollment in and/or completed their first-year full or part time in law school, and should be (1) currently attending one of the following law schools: University of California Berkeley School of Law; University of California Davis School of Law (King Hall); UC College of the Law (formerly University of California Hastings College of the Law); McGeorge School of Law; Santa Clara University School of Law; Stanford Law School; or University of San Francisco School of Law or (2) applying for attendance at one of the aforementioned schools (with the understanding that the scholarship will only be granted to the recipient once enrollment at one of the above schools has been confirmed).
- Applicants must be students who identify as a member of a historically underrepresented community, including any student that identifies as BIPOC, any member of the LGBTQIA+ community, any member of the disabled community, and/or any student with a background or experience that would otherwise contribute to the diversity of the legal profession.

A group of our attorneys and staff make up the panel of judges who will review the applications.

Scholarship recipients will be chosen based upon merit. The panel of judges will consider each applicant's academic accomplishments, background, activities, obligations, and their commitment to community service. Preference will be given to applicants demonstrating a commitment to working and living in the greater Sacramento area after the completion of their legal studies.

All completed applications must be received by **June 15th of the year in which they plan to be enrolled for classes in the Fall of that year.** Scholarship recipients will be notified during the last week of July prior to starting classes that Fall, and will receive their scholarship checks shortly thereafter.

Scholarship recipients will also receive a paid Summer internship with the Firm during the Summer following the school year in which they received the scholarship.
